

BIG IDEA: Jesus is relevant.

SUMMARY

We are celebrating a new year, new decade, and new season. It's a time of new beginnings, fresh starts, and second chances in Jesus' name. Rather than introducing a new theme or word for our church, we are declaring that Jesus is more than enough. We are focusing our hearts toward Him. Our prayer is that this will be one of the greatest years of our lives as we learn how to live free as beloved sons and daughters.

KEY POINTS

1. RELEVANCY OF JESUS

- "If we are honest, it's really easy to forget that Jesus is more than enough even in a Jesus-focused environment." **(2 Corinthians 11:3)**
- "Relevancy is determined by truth not feelings." **(John 11:25)**
- "Instead of losing weight, making money, or changing your habits—what if your vision for 2020 was simply Jesus?" **(Matthew 6:33)**
- "He is the creator, sustainer, and redeemer of all things. He is the most relevant thing in the universe whether we believe it or not."
- "He's not a compartment of your life, He is the one that keeps it all together." **(Psalm 90:2)**
- "Something is relevant when it's worthy of our attention, affection, and focus."
- "We make decisions every day on what is relevant or what is not relevant in our life." **(Matthew 4:17-20)**

What would your life be like if Jesus was your vision for the year?

2. JESUS' MESSAGE

- "Repent, change your thinking from the worldly way to the Kingdom way." **(Matthew 4:17)**
- "Jesus interrupts our life with grace and invites us to grace." **(Matthew 4:17-20)**
- "We have to stop looking at God through the world and look at the world through the Kingdom."
- "He sees your dreams, desires, purposes, destinies. He sees not just who you are but who you can be."
- "He's much better at the making than we are at following."

Where is Jesus inviting you to repent?

3. FOLLOWING IS MOVING FORWARD EVEN WHEN WE DON'T UNDERSTAND AND OBEYING EVEN WHEN WE DON'T LIKE IT.

- "You are either following Jesus or leading yourself."
- "We aren't trying to help you feel good; we are trying to help you live free."
- "When you catch grace you'll be able to follow Him into the life He has for you."
- "God wants you to follow Him for your good not His good."
- "We don't always follow because we don't believe He's more than enough to be a good shepherd. **(John 10:14, 27)**
- "Jesus sees you; He's calling to you, and you get to decide if you are going to let go and move forward or not."
