X-TRAORDINARY

For the next few weeks in Valley Creek Kids, we are learning that because we are part of God's family, we are extraordinary. Extraordinary means different, or special. God created you to be extraordinary and He has a special plan for your life — to share His hope with the world.

1. Use your Bible to fill in the blanks below:

“Before I formed _____ in the womb I _____ you, before you were _____ I set you apart; I appointed _____ as a prophet to the nations.” (Jeremiah 1:5)

In this Bible verse, God is telling Jeremiah that He created him and knew him before he was even born. Before Jeremiah was even born, God had a plan for his life. He made Jeremiah to be set apart, or extraordinary! The same is true for us. God created us to be extraordinary and He chose us specifically to serve Him by sharing His hope.
